

## Installation Guide for Roofer's Edge Extender

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

## FASCIA, COPING, OR TRIM ABOVE 1-1/2-IN, SS RING SHANK NAILS, PROVIDED Installation Guide for 1-1/2-IN Roofer's Edge Extender ROOFER'S EDGE EXTENDER FASCIA CAP FORMED IN 10-FT. LENGTHS FACE MIN= 2-IN. MAX= 8-IN. -1-1/2-IN. SS RING SHANK NAILS, PROVIDED FOR FACE SIZES > 4-IN. 5/8-IN. - 24GA GALV CLEAT FORMED IN 10-FT. LENGTHS, FOR FACE SIZES > 4-IN. FOR MASONRY APPLICATIONS, PLEASE CONTACT OMG. CONTACT OMG FOR APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATIONS NEEDED TO MEET/EXCEED ANSI/SPRI/FM4435/ES-1 DESIGN CRITERIA NOTES: #1 - Isolate all metal parts from ACQ treated wood or other galvanically incompatible material with appropriate membrane material. #2 - Appliance attachments, such as lightning rods, signs, or antennae that penetrate the edge system, induce a galvanic reaction, or otherwise compromise the effectiveness of the roof edge system, shall be eliminated or isolated to prevent problems per ANSI/SPRI/FM4435/ES-1. Lightning protection systems for example must not be directly affixed to the product provided by OMG. Consult OMG for alternative attachment suggestions. D 1-1/2" SS RING SHANK NAIL

- **A. Fascia Cover** 10'-0" Lengths
- **B. Galvanized Anchor Cleat** for face size > 4" 10'-0" Lengths


- C. 1-1/2" SS Ring Shank Nail at 12" o.c. (6" from ends) (Included & Required)
- **D. Fascia, Coping, or Trim above** (Product may vary)





## **STEP 1**: Installing Anchor Cleat (not required for face size ≤ 4")


Place the top edge of the anchor cleat level on the wall face and press cleats securely in position and nail through cleat using 1-1/2" ss ring shank nails provided at the locations shown above and at 12" O.C. For miter application, fit into corner as required to maintain a continuous anchor cleat line. Then nail at a max. of 6" in each direction from the corner or closer at special conditions.




## **STEP 2**: Installing Fascia Straight Lengths

Notch each drip of field fabricated miter 3". Then notch the drip of following 10'-0" piece as shown above. Install the fascia by hooking the drip of the fascia onto the kick out of the cleat and rotate back to the wall. Fasten with 1-1/2" SS ring shank nails provided in each pre-punched hole. Consider lengths of all straight pieces prior to cutting to avoid creating relatively short sections of fascia adjacent to full length sections.

Note: Notch the drip of the 1st pc. to allow overlapping of the next adjacent piece.





STEP 3: Installing Product Above

Install product above fascia per manufacturer's installation instructions.
